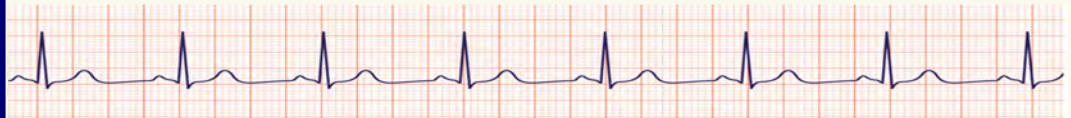

The influenza vaccination is required for all DoDEA students. As of November 13th we still have a large portion of our student population who need to be vaccinated for the influenza. There are only 5 more opportunities to get vaccinated. Send a PDF record of the vaccination as proof.

These influenza clinics are open to EVERYONE regardless of whether you are a servicemember, family member, or a contractor. Please access the Army Health Clinic Stuttgart's website for the most current and up to date information about the influenza vaccination drive. <https://mhs-europe.tricare.mil/Stuttgart>

The PDF file format is preferred because the vaccination record needs printed as a primary source documentation and stays in the student's record. You can use the notes section on an I-phone or the Google drive app on Google phones to scan the card into PDF format.
