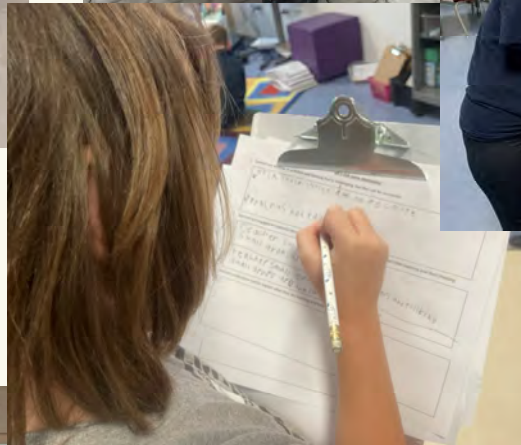
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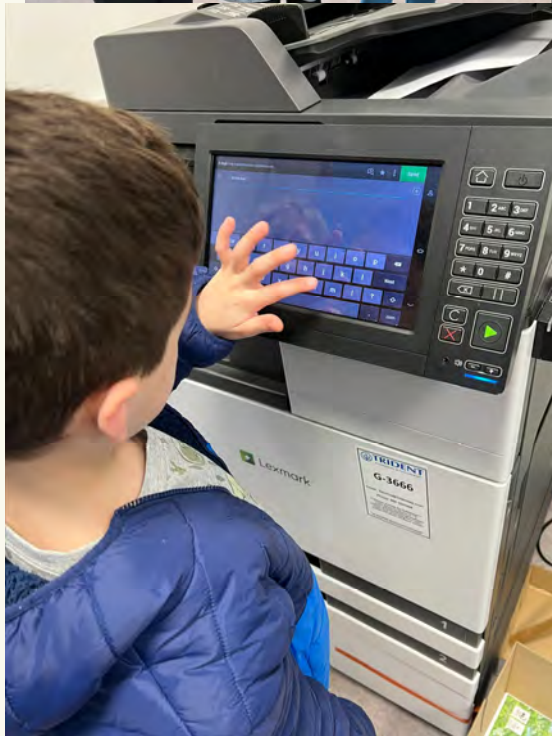
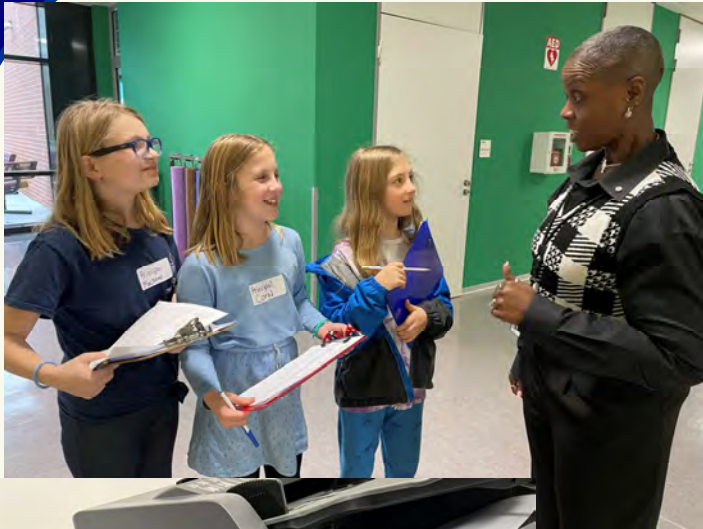
# Celebrating Student Administrators of the Day

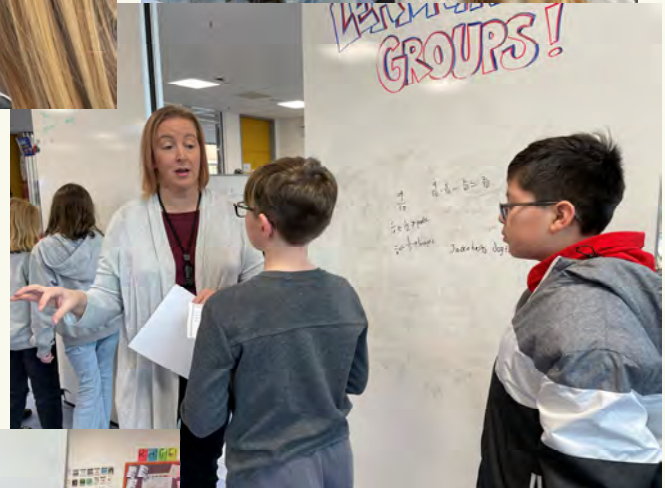
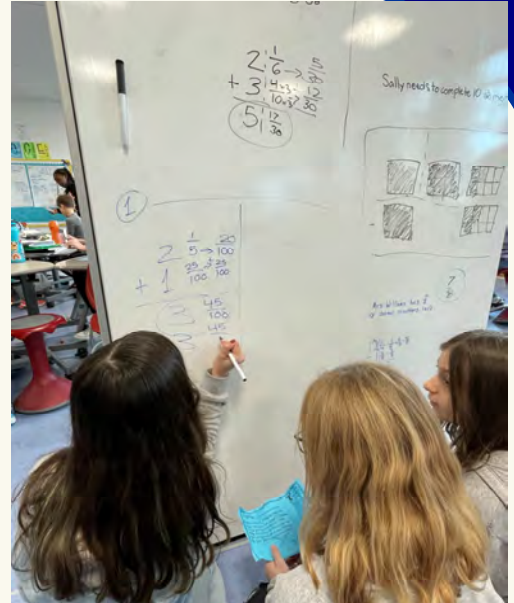


# Celebrating STAR Stallions
